2. What services are currently supported at CSU?

- Arts & Sciences Tutoring Program
 - Science & math tutors are supported financially (paid)
 - Liberal Arts tutors are supported through ongoing training, and with course credit
- Academic Advancement Center
 - AAC and Arts and Sciences Tutoring in TILT already collaborate for beginning of the semester tutor training and use the international CRLA tutor training guidelines.
- ASME (Mechanical Engineering) offers tutoring
- Academic Village Tutoring
- Physics—Graduate students tutor courses
- Beta Alpha Psi – Free tutoring for Accounting majors
- Eagle Feather Tutoring—Free tutoring through the Native American Cultural Center
- TILT Study Groups
- Supplemental Instruction through the College of Natural Sciences for Key Communities
- PACe Tutors through the Math Department
- The Writing Center
- Some departments offer lists of students available to hire for tutoring.
- Some department provide access to graduate students for drop-in tutoring for intro courses and/or maintain a list of "approved" private tutors, although the approval process is often informal. In departments such as the Department of Foreign Languages, the department maintains a list of private tutors (from University & community) which it provides to students upon request (potential private tutors must complete paperwork and be approved by department).
- Some honor societies on campus offer free tutoring.
