We are seeking a dynamic individual to join our team as a research assistant at [Movement Neuroscience and Rehabilitation \(MNR\) Laboratory](#) at Department of Health and Exercise Science at Colorado State University. The research focus of the MNR laboratory is to understand the cognitive and motor mechanisms underlying mobility impairments in older adults and those with neurological impairments.

Primary job responsibilities

1. Participant recruitment and pre-screening. Participants will include healthy older adults, and individuals with stroke, Alzheimer's disease, and mild dementia.
2. Reaching out to potential participants including Latinx, African American and other minority populations (V/WC).
3. Preparing recruitment materials as requested by the Principal Investigator, such as flyers, presentations, advertisements, power-point slide in both English and Spanish (V/WC).
4. Developing relations and presenting the research study to the community partners, support groups, and senior residents.
5. Serving as the primary contact to ensure appropriate communications with the potential and current study participants and the research team (PA).
6. Timely communications with internal teams, investigators, and study participants (PA).
7. Working under the supervision of the Principal Investigator(s), while exercising excellent clinical judgment in participant recruitment, monitoring and testing (IT/GC).

Qualifications

- 1) Fluency in spoken and written communication in Spanish and English (V/WC).
- 2) Experience in creating graphics and marketing materials for recruitment (V/WC).
- 3) Experience working with clinical populations
- 4) High level of motivation, people skills, and ability to self-learn in a new environment (SR).
- 5) Superior work ethics, communication, code documentation skills, as well as intellectual independence (PA).
