1	The research objective was unclear or poorly explained.	The explanation of the project was unclear, or the presentation's organization lacked coherence. The presenter seemed familiar with the material. They spoke clearly and loudly, and they used intonation changes to maintain interest. The speaker used several gestures and some eye contact.
4	The objective and rationale, and significance of the project was clearly stated at the beginning of the presentation. The significance of the project/outcomes was summarized at the end.	The project's stages/methods and outcomes were sufficiently explained. The connection between the approach, objective, and outcomes was clear. One or two aspects of the presentation were over- or under-explained.	This presentation was mostly appropriate for a general audience. General language was used throughout the presentation, and the student incorporated several examples or comparisons to increase understanding.	The visual aid was well-designed. The speaker incorporated the visual aid into their presentation at various moments. The visual aid boosted the presentation's clarity.	The presentation was interesting to listen to and watch. The presenter was familiar with the material and conveyed confidence. Good intonation changes, eye contact, and gestures were present. Enthusiastic delivery enhanced this presentation.
5	The project's objective, rationale, and significance were clear. Background info about the project and broader field was provided. The project's significance was highlighted several times.	The project's approach and outcomes were sufficiently explained. The connection between the stages/setup, objective, and outcomes was clear. Any more or less detail would have made this presentation less effective.	This presentation was excellent for a general audience. Student fully explained all terms, provided background information based on common knowledge, and incorporated many examples and comparisons to increase understanding.	The visual aid was well-designed and well-incorporated into the presentation. The visual aid greatly increased clarity, and the presentation would not have been as successful without the visual aid.	The presentation was interesting to listen to and watch. The presenter was familiar with the material and conveyed confidence. The student used intonation changes, eye contact, and gestures effectively and moved around during the presentation. Enthusiastic delivery greatly enhanced this presentation.
