Creative Writing - RUBRIC

Please note: Judging creative work is based largely on the reader's emotional response and on the sense that there is a driving concern (or concerns) or question (or questions) that the author pursues with clarity, thoughtfulness and compassion. Form is also highly important and should reflect the driving concerns and questions of the piece. In prose, one should consider the criteria in relation to: point-of-view; plot; setting; characterization, dialogue, world building, etc. In poetry, one should consider the criteria in relation to: voice; imagery; timing; sound quality, and visual life on the page, etc.
